

Visitation and Outpatient Guidelines

The community rate of infectious disease is over 30%

As determined by CCH, state and federal regulatory authorities



No visiting allowed with few exceptions (see below)



All visitors, and outpatients required to be screened and wear a mask and additional PPE as necessary



Visitors must be 16 years of age or older to visit inpatients



All visitors should perform hand hygiene before entering the patient's room
All visits must occur in the patient's room

End of Life

- No cap on number of visitors in a single day
- Unlimited duration of visit

Behavioral Health Services

- Check with the unit directly for visitation hours and guidelines

Maternal Child

- One support person may be admitted 24 hours per day

Outpatients

- Outpatients may not have a support person accompany them to an appointment or procedure
- Exceptions may be made for pediatrics, altered mental status and outpatients with physical/developmental delays

No visitation is allowed unless the patient is at end of life.

Exceptions may be made for pediatrics, end of life, altered mental status and patients with physical/developmental delays.

Visitors must be trained on donning and doffing of appropriate PPE.
