Submission Deadline: September 30, 2025

Submissions will be evaluated for practical application of material, relevance to EMS in the NE Wyoming region, timely or innovative topic, clearly identified objectives, overall quality & well-defined focus, availability, and type of presentation.

Notification of Selection: Applicants will be notified no later than October 31, 2025

Presenter Agreements: Signed no later than November 30, 2025. Please note that participation as a presenter is contingent upon receiving your signed Agreement by this date. Presenters who submit their Agreements after this date may not be included in marketing materials and the conference program.
