## Code Red → fire / explosion

R.A.C.E.E. / P.A.S.S



## Code Blue → cardiac/pulmonary emergency

Code Blue Buttons throughout facility
If accidental code blue activation, notify PBX



### Code Black → tornado / severe weather

The national weather service has alerted that funnel is in the vicinity of CCH. Weather radios throughout the facility.

Move patients to safety ASAP.






Administration will activate the disaster call list. Internal or external disaster, CCH might have more patients than normal staffing can handle.



## Code Orange chemical spill or hazardous material





#### Code Pink → infant or child abduction

Block elevators and doorways, so no one leaves the building. Search for infant or child as announced.



## Code Gray → man power needed

A show of support All staff and supervisors trained to respond should. Be a presence, stand together, show support for the staff, do not speak, trained staff will interact with patient.



#### Code Zebra → bioterrorism

A national alert if there is an attack, Campbell County and The State have a plan.



#### Code W → wanderer

Announced if a patient/resident has wondered away from the unit. All available staff will search.



**Code OB** 

Indicates a critical emergency related to a delivery. Only staff with OB experience should respond to Delivery rooms STAT.



#### **Code Silver**

Hostage situation or active shooter or threat of violence. Goal is to ensure a safe, secure environment for patients, visitors and staff.



# Code M.H. Malignant Hyperthermia

An emergency situation involving a patient's reaction to specific anesthetic agents. House Supervisor, ECD Nurse, Lab, Pharmacy and CPS respond to the location to aid in emergency treatment.
