

# Visitation and Outpatient Guidelines

## The community rate of infectious disease is 1-10%

As determined by CCH, state and federal regulatory authorities



Inpatient Visiting Hours –  
7:00 am-8:30 pm,  
exceptions apply for end  
of life visits



All visitors, outpatients  
and support persons are  
required to be screened  
and wear a mask and  
additional PPE as necessary



Visitors must be 16 years  
of age or older to visit  
inpatients



All visitors should perform  
hand hygiene before  
entering the patient's room  
All visits must occur in the  
patient's room

### General visitation

- No more than two visitors allowed in one 24-hour period
- Visitors may leave and come back, but must be screened each time they enter the building
- Do not visit if ill
- Visitors should sign in at the nurse's station
- Length of visit is unlimited during visiting hours

### End of Life

- No cap on number of visitors in a single day
- Unlimited duration of visit

### Behavioral Health Services

- Check with the unit directly for visitation hours and guidelines

### Maternal Child

- Designated visitors may be admitted 24 hours per day
- No more than two visitors allowed in the patient's room at any time
- Visiting may be restricted at any time based on the condition of the patient

### Outpatients

- Outpatients may have up to two support persons accompany them to an appointment or procedure
- Please do not bring children under age 16 to accompany you to your appointment or procedure.

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## No visitation is allowed for COVID-19 or suspected COVID-19 patients, or any patient in isolation unless the patient is at end of life.

Exceptions may be made for pediatrics, end of life, altered mental status and patients with physical/developmental delays.

Visitors must be trained on donning and doffing of appropriate PPE.
